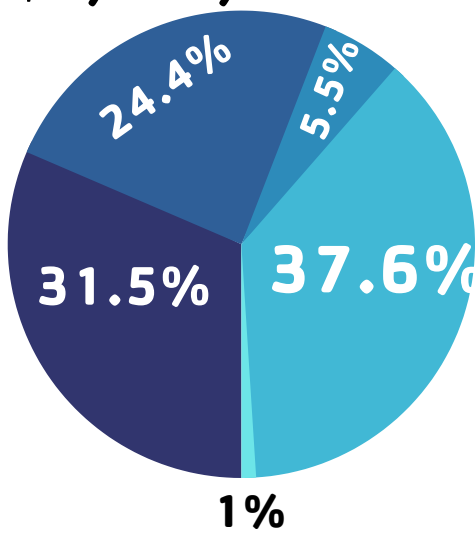

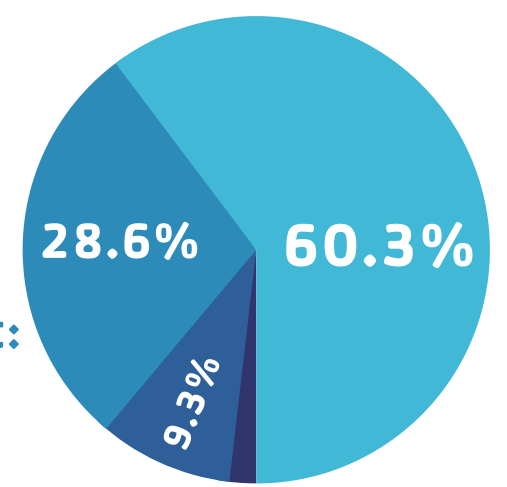


2021 Operating Revenues* \$2,021,944
